- 1. All registration fees are non-refundable and we reserve the right to re-sell the pitch if you are unable to attend.
- 2. Sub-letting of your camping pitch is not permitted.
- 3. Campers are requested not to arrive at the Festival before 4pm on Friday to avoid causing any inconvenience to local residents.
- Only ONE motor vehicle, plus accommodation, is allowed per motorised pitch (8m x 8m) and to ensure free movement around the campsite for emergency vehicles, these must be kept within the marked area.
- 5. No vehicles are permitted on a Cycle-Camper pitch.
- 6. All other vehicles **MUST** be left in the day parking field and not on campsite access or perimeter roads. There will be a charge of £5.00 per vehicle for the weekend or part of.
- For safety reasons, no vehicle movements will be allowed during events that cross roadways.
- 8. If you must bring dogs onto the Festival Ground, please ensure that they are kept on a lead and under control at all times. They are not permitted in any Festival buildings.
- 9. For reasons of safety open fires are not permitted.
- 10. Campers are asked to refrain from playing music and other loud activities between 11.00pm and 7.00am.
- 11. There must be no movement of vehicles between 11.00pm and 7.00am. If you do come back onto site during this time please park in the Village Hall car-park. The campsite gates will be closed during the above hours for increased security.
